Online Registration: Team and athlete entries for individual events are submitted by the respective Regional Committees, upon invitation from the Organising Committee, online on the Federal website by Monday 26th May at 24:00.

Bib Collection: Bibs for all events will be collected by a Committee official at the T.I.C. no later than 17:30 on 30th May.

Entry Confirmation: Confirmation of entries must be carried out by a representative of each team by 19:00 on 30th May at the TIC at the Bressanone sports facility.

Changes may be made up to 60 minutes before each individual event by a team representative.

Confirmation of relay teams with the running order of relay legs must be submitted no later than 60 minutes before the respective event.

Technical Meeting: The technical meeting will be held in the stadium press room on 30th May at 17:30. One delegate per team must attend.

Technical Programme

Men

- **Track:** 100 m – 200 m – 400 m – 800 m – 1500 m – 110 H – 400 H – 2000 SC – 4x100
- 5000 m Race Walk
- **Jumps:** Pole Vault – Triple Jump – High Jump – Long Jump
- **Throws:** Hammer – Shot Put – Discus – Javelin

Women

- **Track:** 100 m – 200 m – 400 m – 800 m – 1500 m – 100 H – 400 H – 2000 SC – 4x100 – 5000 m Race Walk
- **Jumps:** Pole Vault – Triple Jump – High Jump – Long Jump
- **Throws:** Hammer – Shot Put – Discus – Javelin

Call Room

- 20 minutes before track, race walk and relay events;
- 30 minutes for horizontal jumps and shot put;
- 40 minutes for hammer throw, javelin throw, discus throw;
- 40 minutes for high jump;

- 50 minutes for pole vault.

The actual call room schedule will be posted at the Call Room entrance and in the warm-up area. No announcements will be made over the loudspeaker.

Access to and exit from the competition area: The entire competition area will be supervised by designated personnel. Athletes will access the competition field exclusively through the Call Room, following the appointed Judge. They will exit exclusively accompanied by judges, always in single file, through the Mixed Zone, at the end of the event.

Event participation: Each team has the right to enter one athlete per event; for the 4x100 relays, 4 athletes may be entered.

Each athlete may compete in two individual events or in one individual event plus the 4x100 relay.

Relay teams may be composed of athletes entered in other events on the programme, or of athletes entered exclusively for the relays.

Athletes entered exclusively for relays may also compete in the 100 m extra race.

Access to finals in field events: In the triple jump, long jump and the four throwing events, the top eight athletes after the first 3 attempts qualify for the 3 final attempts.

Composition of heats in track events: Heats for the 100 m, 200 m, 400 m, 110 H, 100 H, 400 H and 800 m will be composed based on entry times achieved in 2024 and 2025.

Athletes with the best times will run in the last heat.

Lane assignments are made randomly, regardless of the athlete's entry time.

Equipment (men's javelin) 700 g: Athletes must use the new IAAF 2025 javelin in accordance with World Athletics Rule RT 38.10 rev. 2025.

Progression Bars in Vertical Jumps

Men's High Jump: 1.60 – 1.65 – 1.70 – 1.75 – 1.78 – 1.81 – 1.84 – 1.87 – 1.90 – 1.92 + 2

Men's Pole Vault: 2.70 – 3.00 – 3.20 – 3.40 – 3.60 – 3.80 – 4.00 – 4.10 + 10

Women's High Jump: 1.40 – 1.45 – 1.50 – 1.55 – 1.60 – 1.63 – 1.66 – 1.69 – 1.72 – 1.75 – 1.77 + 2

Women's Pole Vault: 2.10 – 2.40 – 2.70 – 3.00 – 3.20 – 3.40 – 3.50 – 3.55 – 3.65 + 5

Protests: Protests regarding an athlete's eligibility to compete must be submitted to the Technical Delegate before the start of the meeting, or in any case before the individual event. Protests concerning the conduct of an event must be submitted verbally to the Referee of the specific event no later than 30 minutes after the official announcement of results. Any appeal must be submitted in writing to the Appeals Jury, accompanied by the required fee of €100.00 (refundable if upheld). The appeal must be delivered at the TIC, upon presentation of the federal membership card, within 30 minutes of the Referee/Technical Delegate's communication of the decision being appealed.

Awards: The first three placed athletes in each event will be awarded. Award ceremonies will take place within 15 minutes of the official announcement of results for each event. Athletes to be awarded will be escorted by Judges or designated personnel to the area reserved for the ceremony.

Team Standings: The winner of each of the 18 events in the technical programme earns 16 team points, second place earns 15 points, decreasing by one point down to 16th place.

Unclassified athletes receive no points.

Individual athletes not representing a team receive no team points.

For the team standings, all points earned across the 36 different events are totalled.

In the event of a tie, the first criterion is the table score (FIDAL table) across the 36 results; in the case of a further tie, the sum of the best technical result women + men (FIDAL table).

How to reach the venue

By car: from the north – exit Bressanone Nord, then state road to Bressanone; from the south – exit Chiusa, then state road northward to Bressanone.

By train: Bressanone railway station, approx. 1 km from the stadium.
