**Online Registration:** Team and athlete entries for individual events are submitted by the respective Regional Committees, upon invitation from the Organising Committee, online on the Federation website by Monday 25 May at 24:00.

**Bib Collection:** Bibs for all events will be collected by a Committee official at the T.I.C. by 17:30 on 30 May.

**Entry Confirmation:** Confirmation of entries must be carried out by a representative of each team by 19:00 on 30 May at the TIC at the Bressanone sports ground.

Changes may be made up to 60 minutes before each individual event by a team representative.

Confirmation of relay teams, including the order of runners, must be submitted no later than 60 minutes before the start of the relay.

**Technical Meeting:** A technical meeting will be held in the press room at the stadium at 17:30 on 30 May. One delegate per team must attend.

### Technical Programme

#### Men

**Track:** 100 m – 200 m – 400 m – 800 m – 1500 m – 110 H – 400 H – 2000 SC – 4×100

5000 m Race Walk

**Jumps:** Pole Vault – Triple Jump – High Jump – Long Jump

**Throws:** Hammer – Shot Put – Discus – Javelin

#### Women

**Track:** 100 m – 200 m – 400 m – 800 m – 1500 m – 100 H – 400 H – 2000 SC – 4×100 – 5000 m Race Walk

**Jumps:** Pole Vault – Triple Jump – High Jump – Long Jump

**Throws:** Hammer – Shot Put – Discus – Javelin

### Call Room

#### Check-in times before events:

- 20 minutes before for running, race walking, and relay events
- 30 minutes before for horizontal jumps and shot put
- 40 minutes before for hammer throw, javelin throw, discus throw
- 40 minutes before for high jump
- 50 minutes before for pole vault

The actual field entry time will be posted near the Call Room entrance and in the warm-up area. No announcements will be made via loudspeaker.

**Access to and exit from the competition area:** The entire competition area will be supervised by designated staff. Athletes will enter the competition area exclusively through the Call Room, following the designated Judge. They will leave exclusively accompanied by judges, always in a single file, through the Mixed Zone, at the end of the event.

**Event Participation:** Each team has the right to enter one athlete per event. For the 4×100 relay events, 4 athletes may be entered.

**Each athlete may compete in two individual events or one individual event plus the 4×100 relay.**

Relay teams may be composed of athletes also entered in other events of the technical programme, or of athletes entered exclusively for the relay.

Athletes entered only in relays may also compete in the extra 100 m event.

**Access to finals in field events:** In the triple jump, long jump, and all four throwing events, the top eight athletes after the first 3 attempts qualify for 3 additional final attempts.

**Heat composition for running events:** Heats for the 100 m, 200 m, 400 m, 110 H, 100 H, 400 H and 800 m will be composed based on entry times achieved in 2025 and 2026.

Athletes with the best times will run in the last heat.

Lane draws are carried out randomly, regardless of the athlete's entry time.

**Implements (Men's Javelin) 700 g:** Athletes must use the new IAAF 2025 javelin in accordance with World Athletics Rule RT 38.10, rev. 2025.

**Height progressions in vertical jumps:**

Men's High Jump: 1.60 – 1.65 – 1.70 – 1.75 – 1.78 – 1.81 – 1.84 – 1.87 – 1.90 – 1.92 + 2

Men's Pole Vault: 2.70 – 3.00 – 3.20 – 3.40 – 3.60 – 3.80 – 4.00 – 4.10 + 10

Women's High Jump: 1.40 – 1.45 – 1.50 – 1.55 – 1.60 – 1.63 – 1.66 – 1.69 – 1.72 – 1.75 – 1.77 + 2

Women's Pole Vault: 2.10 – 2.40 – 2.70 – 3.00 – 3.20 – 3.40 – 3.50 – 3.55 – 3.65 + 5

**Protests:** Protests regarding the eligibility of an athlete to compete in an event must be submitted to the Technical Delegate before the start of the competition, or in any case before the individual event. Protests concerning the conduct of an event must be submitted verbally to the Referee of the specific event within 30 minutes of the official announcement of results. Each appeal must be submitted in writing to the Jury of Appeal, accompanied by the prescribed fee of €100.00 (refundable if upheld). The appeal must be delivered to the TIC, upon presentation of the federation membership card, within 30 minutes of the Referee's/Technical Delegate's communication of the decision being appealed.

**Awards:** The top three finishers in each event will be awarded. Award ceremonies will take place within 15 minutes of the official announcement of results for each event. Athletes to be awarded will be escorted by judges or designated personnel to the area reserved for the award ceremony.

**Team Standings:** The winner of each of the 18 events in the technical programme earns 16 team points; second place earns 15 points, decreasing by one point down to 16th place.

No points are awarded to unranked athletes.

Individual athletes, if any, do not receive team points.

For the team standings, all points accumulated across the 36 individual events are totalled.

In the event of a tie, the first criterion is the FIDAL table score among the 36 results; in case of a further tie, the sum of the best technical result (women + men, FIDAL table) applies.

**How to reach the venue:**

**By car:** From the north: exit at Bressanone Nord, then follow the main road to Bressanone. From the south: exit at Chiusa, then follow the main road north to Bressanone.

**By train:** Bressanone railway station is 1 km from the stadium.
